ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF CITRICULTURE

I

The name of this corporation shall be INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF CITRICULTURE.

II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) The specific and primary purposes are to promote and encourage research, exchange of information, and education in all aspects of citrus production, harvesting, handling and distribution of both fresh fruit and products.
- (b) The general purposes and powers are to sponsor international meetings, prepare and publish papers and reports on problems of the citrus industry, to prepare and distribute information and materials useful to citrus growing, marketing and financing, and to develop and promote international exchange of information valuable to those engaged in research, education, production and distribution of citrus.

III

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

IV

The county in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is located is Riverside County.

VI

The authorized number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the By-Laws.

VII

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or is distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

VIII

Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets, remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational or scientific purposes and which has established its exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Any assets not so disposed of exclusively for such purposes shall be distributed to such organization as may be directed by a decree of the Superior Court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.

IX

The name of the unincorporated association which is being incorporated is INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF CITRICULTURE.
